

Local Teams



- Each hospital will have one leader
- Local leaders should inform the National Coordinator of the respective country about interest in LASOS.
- Ethical approval of local Institution should be provided
- Site agreement and registration should be done by the local coordinator in Lasos website <https://lasos-study.org/>
- Local coordinator will register the local team in website
- An account will be created for each local team
- We recommend having a team able to collect data from ALL eligible patients operated during the study week (elective, urgent and cesarean section).
- Each local team should collect data on patients operated over a 7-day block period
- There is no **maximum** number of collaborators in a local team
- We recommend that the local team participating include anaesthetists and surgeons, if available.
- Baseline data can be collected in the operating room

Participants Benefits



- Every member of team will be named part of the LASOS group
- All LASOS publications will be published on behalf of the LASOS study group which means all study group members can list these in their curriculum vitae or resume.
- Every investigator will be able to download certificate of participation
- Local investigators will receive data for their hospital if required.
